



## Scarecrow Pumpkin By Keith Grafton

### SUPPLIES:

- Glass Pumpkin #3101-800
- 2.5 Candle Lamp #6202-63
- Straw Hat #1238
- Raffia #2823-53
- Acorn Pick #MC-7048
- Crow #13224
- Sunflower head of choice
- Approx 12in Ribbon of choice
- Americana acrylic paint:
- Burnt Orange / White / Pumpkin / Toffee
- 08 micron pen, floral cling, hot glue, sponge, round brush for painting



### PUTTING IT TOGETHER.....

1. Sponge on toffee to a rounded area on the front of the pumpkin approx 9inches across. Allow to dry.
2. Sponge on pumpkin to create two large cheeks on toffee surface. Allow to dry.
3. With a brush paint rounded triangle with burnt orange to create nose. Allow to dry.
4. Using 08 micron pen draw on face details (eyes, mouth, outline nose) also a couple white highlights on nose.
5. Distress hat cutting out sections and pulling brim down and twisting in your hands.
6. Embellish hat with ribbon, sunflower, acorn pick and crow.
7. Create hair with raffia.
8. Add a small amount of floral cling to the bottom of the candle lamp and place in pumpkin.
9. Light up and enjoy.
