

Valentine Pillar Candle



Materials Needed:

- Mini Bowdabra®
- Bowdabra® Bow Wire
- Ribbon
- Pillar Candle
- Metal Thumb Tacks

- Decorate the outside of a pillar candle with metal thumb tacks. Form a heart shape with the tacks.
- **To make the bow for candle:** Cut a 24" piece of Bowdabra Bow Wire and fold it in half. Lay it into the Mini Bowdabra. You'll have a loop at one end and two loose pieces at the opposite end.
- Lay your ribbon into the Mini Bowdabra. Decide how big you want your loops. To make your first loop, fold the ribbon and press into the Mini Bowdabra.
- Continue folding the ribbon back and forth until you have created as many loops as you desire.
- Scrunch ribbon down with the Mini Bowdabra Wand.
- While the bow is still in the Mini Bowdabra, thread the two loose ends of the Bowdabra Bow Wire through the loop at the other end.
- Pull the Bowdabra Bow Wire tightly while the bow is still in the Mini Bowdabra.
- Gently pull the bow out of the Mini Bowdabra. Separate the two loose ends of the Bowdabra Bow Wire and bring them around to the back of the bow. To tie off the bow, pinch the Bowdabra Bow Wire securely against the bow. Twist the bow 4 to 6 times in a clockwise direction.
- Fluff bow and tie around the front of the candle.
- **Warning: Remove bow before lighting the candle. NEVER leave a candle unattended.**
