

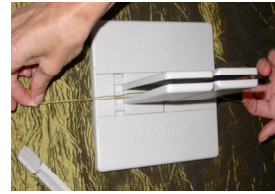
## “GARLAND PEW OR PACKAGE BOW ”

### Supplies:

- 4 Yds. Garland
- 16 Metallic or Chenille Stems 12” long (8 each of 2 colors)
- 36” Bowdabra Bow Wire

### Directions for Garland Pew or Package Bow:

- 1. Cut a 36” piece of Bowdabra Bow Wire & fold it in half. Lay Bow Wire into the Bowdabra. You’ll have a loop at one end & 2 loose pieces at the opposite end. Tuck loop & loose ends under Bowdabra, so that it is out of the way while you work.
- 2. Twist chenille stems around garland alternating color as you work your way down the garland (silver, gold), leaving a few inches at each end free of stems. This should take 12 stems.
- 3. Place garland into Bowdabra 2’ from end (for tail).
- 4. Fold the garland to make a loop (i.e.: 12” loop which will require 24” of garland). Press down into the Bowdabra.
- 5. Repeat this step. You’ll now have a loop on each side of the Bowdabra.
- 6. Continue to create 2 loops on each side leaving a 2’ tail.
- 7. Place the 4 remaining stems on top of the garland.
- 8. Bend stems to make an interesting design.
- 9. Scrunch down everything with the Bowdabra Wand.
- 10. Grasp loose ends of bow wire & feed them through the loop so you tie off as a slip knot.
- 11. Pull the bow wire tight while still in the Bowdabra.
- 12. Take bow out of the Bowdabra. Separate the 2 loose ends of the Bow Wire and bring them around to the back of the bow. To secure, tie a tight knot.
- 13. Fluff bow & arrange and twist stems.
- 14. Leave bow wire long so you can tie bow around the pew or package.
